What I am about to share is just one of many such events in my own life, but before I do I need to make a disclaimer. I want to do this for a couple reasons. The first is because there may be someone reading this who knows my past and how sketchy I can be from time to time. My walk of faith over the past 40 some years has not always been exemplary nor without embarrassment or shame. The fact that God permits anyone to experience "a particular thing" is no promise or guarantee that that person is going to do the right thing from that point on.
